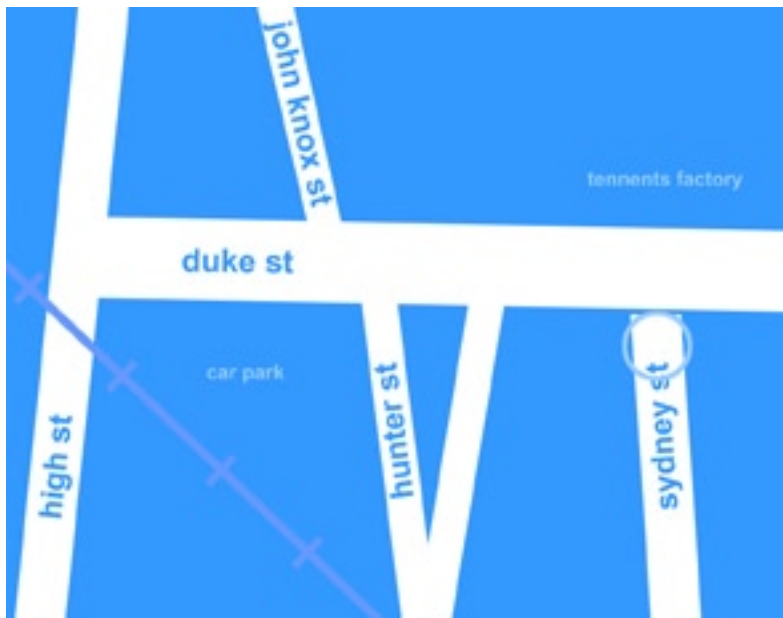


get involved

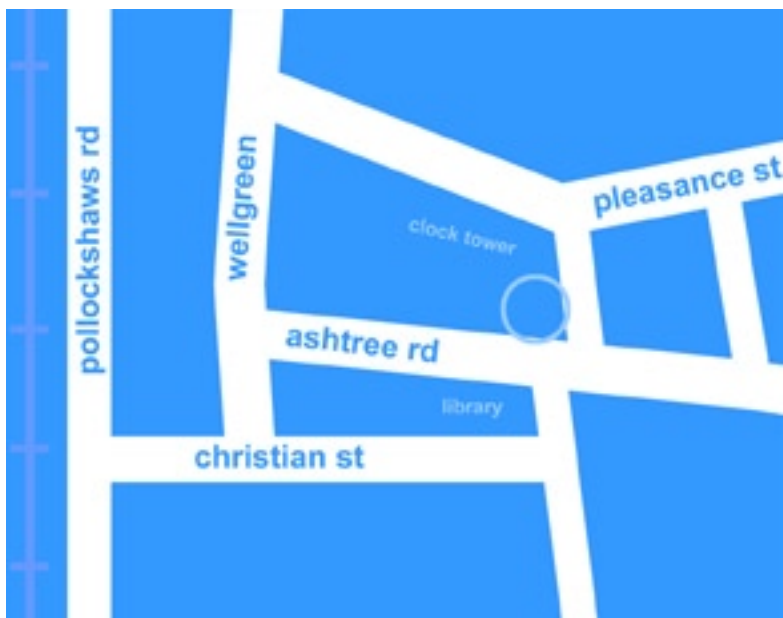

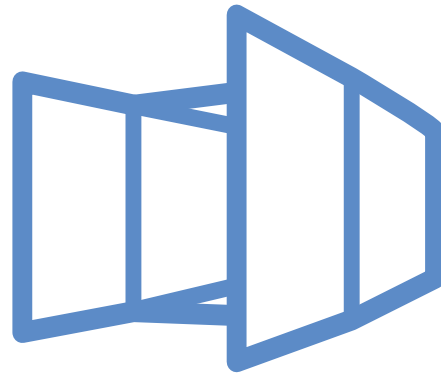

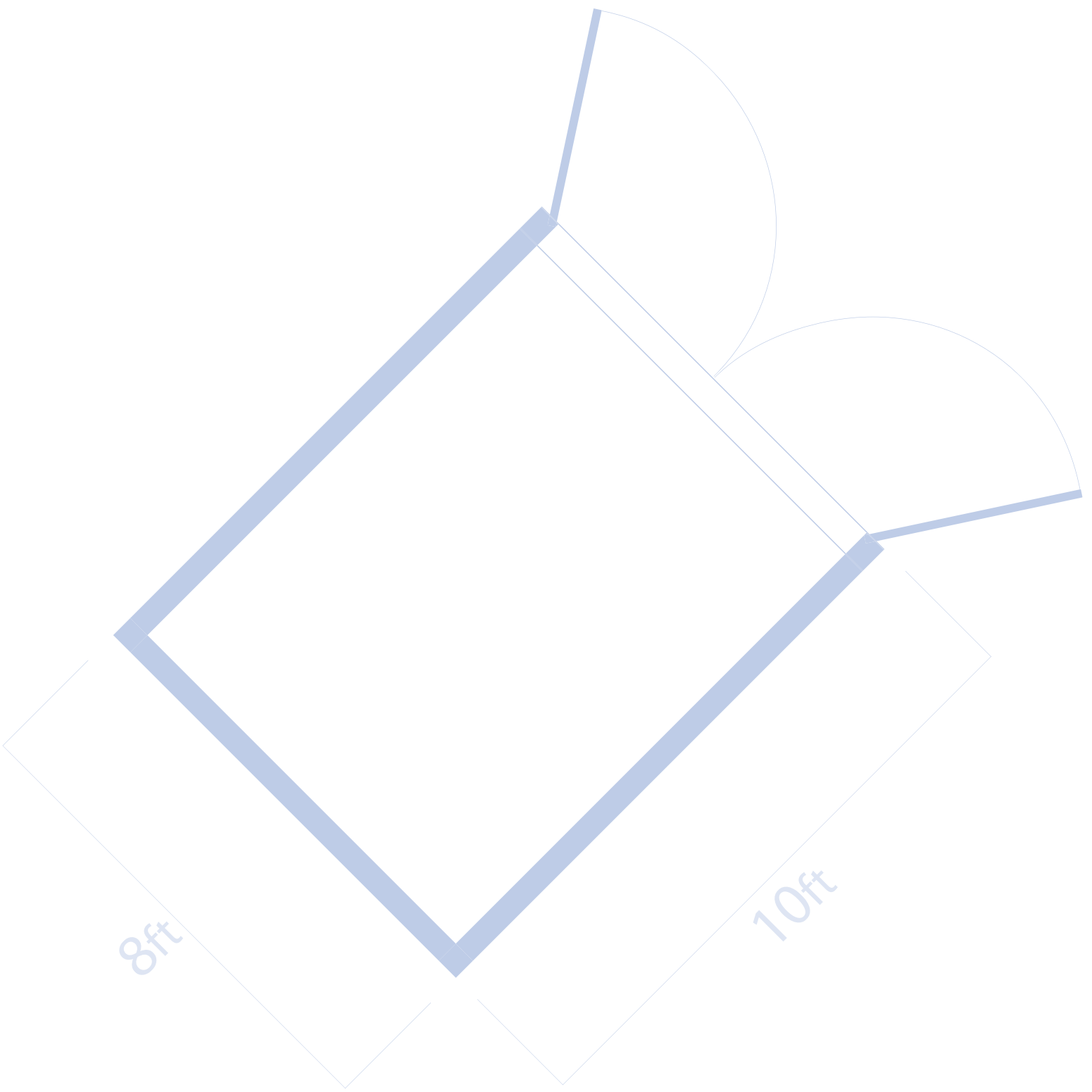

please do not include CV's or past works proposals /ideas must be submitted to cabin exchange by post or via e-mail and to arrive on or before 5pm on the 24th February 2006

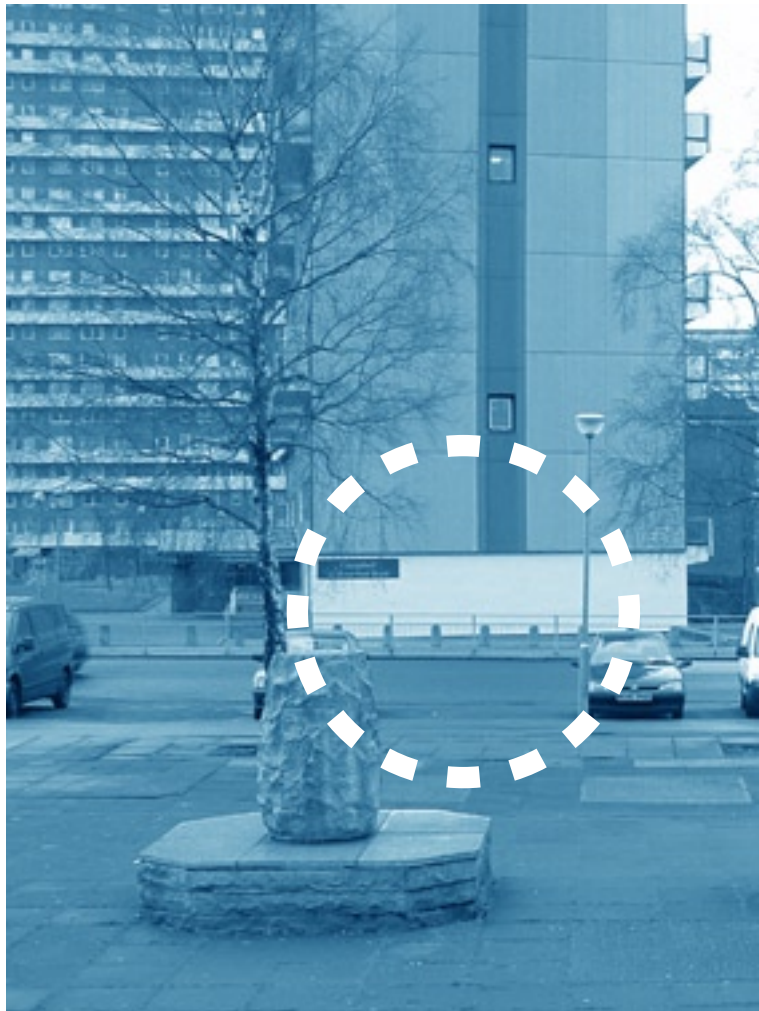

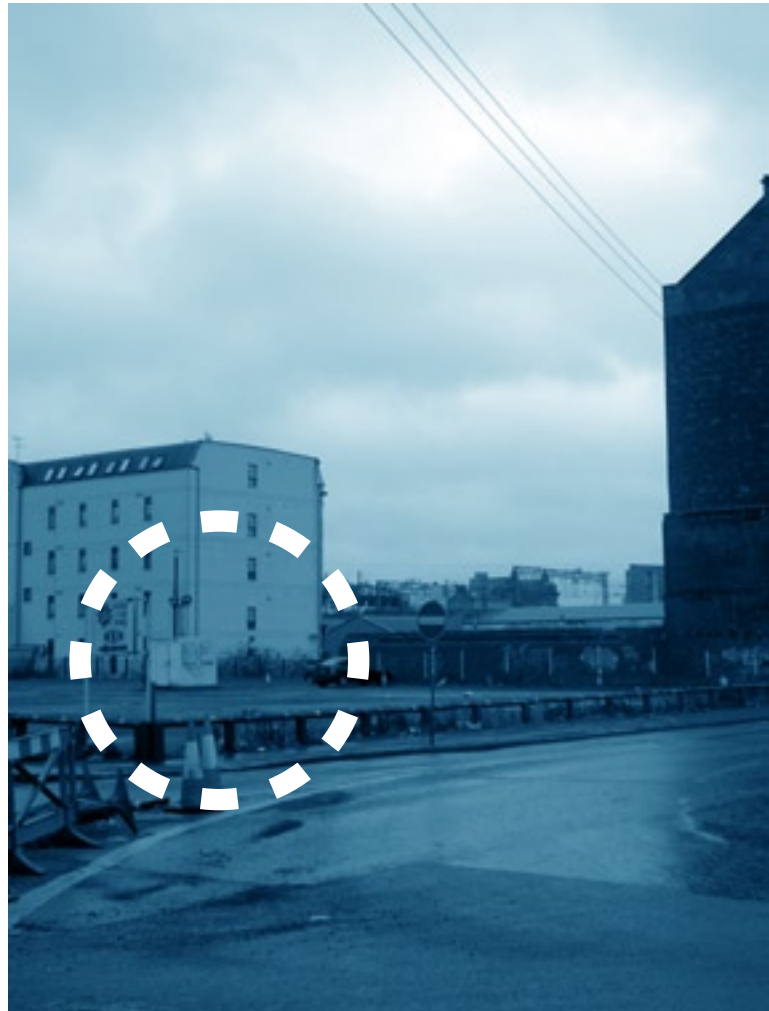
